Prior to her federal service career, Ho was a practicing attorney. She served both in private sector and over four years active duty as an Air Force criminal prosecutor. She continues her military service today as a lieutenant colonel in the Air Force Reserves, where she has helped the Air Force Judge Advocate General's Corps with its diversity and inclusion initiatives. Ho received her degree in civil engineering from Duke University and then earned her Juris Doctor from the University of Florida. Later, she pursued an executive certificate in diversity strategy from Georgetown University. Ho lives in Falls Church, Virginia, with her wonderful husband and three beautiful children.


